**Suitable for:** Customer staff working with ThruPut Manager day-to-day – either as a JAL programmer, operations planner, or software maintainer.

### ThruPut Manager Automation Edition from an Operational Viewpoint

describes the commands and monitoring displays available with ThruPut Manager Automation Edition. It suggests what features are appropriate for what circumstances and highlights some of the new information on the monitoring displays. The session concludes with a discussion on the impact to your datacenter procedures when Automation Edition is fully implemented.

**Suitable for:** Customers implementing or planning to implement Automation Edition.

**Know Your JAL<sup>1</sup>** examines common JAL coding techniques and offers alternative methods to perform the same functionality with improved maintainability. Recent JAL enhancements will also be covered.

**Suitable for:** Customers staff working with ThruPut Manager day-to-day – especially staff working with JAL they inherited.

**Using the Software Access Control (SAC) Table** shows how to set up the table and explains the benefits of controlling software access with the SAC table rather than using only Job Binding.

**Suitable for:** Customer staff wishing to control software access with a minimum of effort. Customers requiring software access control for TSO users.
